Greenland Strategic Minerals A/S Submitted Project Description for the Narsaq Rare Earths Project to Commence Public Pre Consultation

Greenland Strategic Minerals A/S today announced the public release of the *Project Description for the Narsaq Rare Earths Project*, marking a major regulatory milestone in the company's progression toward securing an exploitation licence for one of Greenland's most strategically significant emerging mining developments.

The document—now formally submitted under Section 44 of the Act on Mineral Activities—initiates the review by the Mineral Resource Authority (MRA). Mandatory 35 day public pre consultation period follows. This stage invites comments from authorities, communities, and stakeholders across Greenland and represents the first formal step toward the project's Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA), Social Impact Assessment (SIA), and subsequent licensing stages.

The Project Description outlines the full conceptual framework for the Narsaq Project, including:

- Development of a staged, modular rare-earth mining and processing operation in southern Greenland.
- A mechanical, reagent-free processing route designed for low environmental impact.
- A strong commitment to local employment, skills development, and regional economic participation.
- A logistics strategy leveraging deep-water fjord access for year-round marine operations.
- A long-term vision for sustainable, community-aligned development in the Kujalleq region.

The document also details the project's geological basis, site layout, construction sequencing, operational concept, environmental sensitivities, and stakeholder engagement framework. As stated in the Project Description, *"The Narsaq Rare Earths Project is more than a mining operation—it is a long-term economic and strategic initiative designed to strengthen Greenland's economy, empower its communities, and contribute to global efforts to secure stable, responsible supplies of the minerals needed for modern life."*

Greenland Strategic Minerals A/S welcomes the beginning of this transparent and collaborative process and looks forward to engaging constructively with local communities, government bodies, and industry stakeholders throughout the consultation period.

Partnership with Greenland

- The Narsaq Rare Earths Project is designed as a collaborative venture with Greenland's people, ensuring that local communities are central to its success. "Narsaq" derives from the Greenlandic word meaning *air, sky, weather, and the natural world* — reflecting the Project's commitment to balance, responsibility, and harmony with Greenland's environment and culture.

Strategic Relevance

Narsaq's rare earths are critical for EV motors, wind turbines, semiconductors, aerospace, and defence systems. By providing a secure, non-Chinese source of rare earths, Narsaq supports Western diversification strategies under the EU Critical Raw Materials Act, the U.S. Inflation Reduction Act, and the Defense Production Act.

Market Interest

Early offtake discussions with partners in South Korea and the United States validate Narsaq's economics and reinforce Greenland's role as a trusted supplier of ESG-compliant concentrates.

Next Milestone

The Exploitation Licence application for 3.0 Mtpa was formally submitted in February 2026, positioning Narsaq as Greenland's newest and most credible rare earths development. Following the review by the MRA and public consultation a conditional Exploitation Licence will be granted.
